Abstract

This guideline outlines how authors should format their talk submission for the App Inventor Summit. The talk submission cannot exceed 3 pages. The template font is *Times New Roman*. Section headings should be left aligned, numbered (except the abstract), bold and set to 14 pt. The abstract should be no longer than 300 words.

1. Normal or Body Text

Please use a 12-point Times Roman font or, if this is unavailable, another proportional font with serifs, as close as possible in appearance to Times Roman 12-point.

The submission can include pictures and tables as long as it does not exceed the one page limit. The template font is *Times New Roman*. The title needs to be **centered, bold** and set to 18 pt.

Authors names and affiliation should set to 11pt. There can be as many authors as necessary as long as the submission is no longer than three pages.

The body of the text should be set to 12 pt. Top and bottom margin should be set to be 1; left and right margin should be set to 1.25.

2. Figure/Captions

Place figures and tables on the same page and reference them within the text as "Figure 1". A figure or table may extend across the entire width of the body text.

Captions should be Times New Roman 10 pt bold. They should be numbered (e.g., "Table 1" or "Figure 2"), centered and placed beneath the figure or table. Please note that the words "Figure" and "Table" should be spelled out (e.g., "Figure" rather than "Fig.") wherever they occur.
